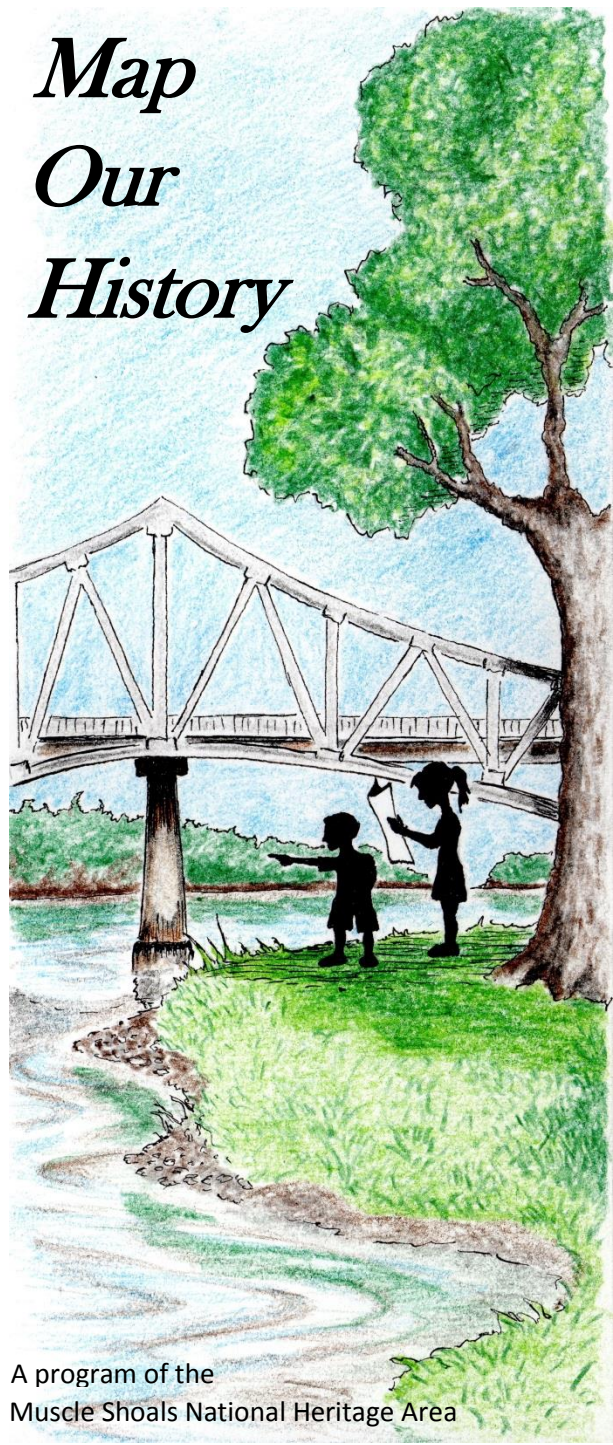

Here's how it works:

- Take this map to MSNHA's 13 Passport® to Your National Park locations listed in this brochure. (Many of these sites are staffed by volunteers and keep irregular hours, so call in advance.)
- After visiting the site, ask for the Passport® to Your National Park cancellation to be stamped next to the site's corresponding location on the map.
- When you've collected all 13, mail, bring or scan and email the map to MSNHA's office. You'll get your map back plus a commemorative coin to celebrate your achievement.
